
Dear Mr. Bockstruck:



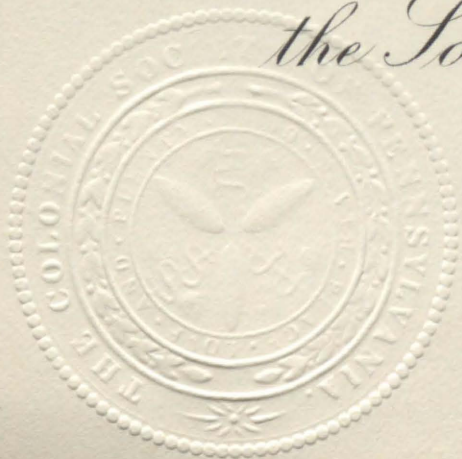
