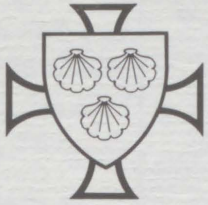


You have been proposed for membership in the Military Order of the Crusades by Sir Clovis H. Brakebill, seconded by Robert M. Clark, Jr.

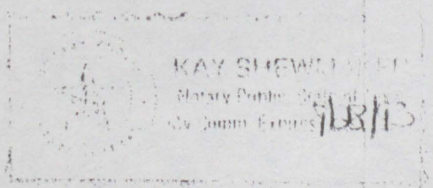

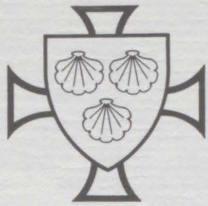
