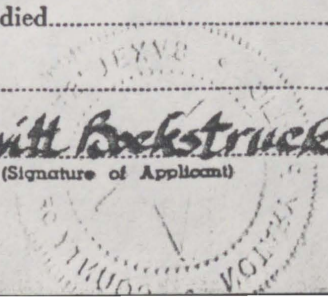

**Authorities Proving Services of Ancestor, with Details**

Sybil Noyes, C.T. Libby, and W. G. Davis, Genealogical Dictionary of Maine and New Hampshire, pp. 437 = 38. Edmund Littlefield immigrated to New England, probably in 1636 or 1637, and was perhaps at Boston; he was first of record in Exeter, N.H. where he signed the combination 5 June 1639. By 1643 he was living at Wells, Maine. At Wells he was Selectman in 1654 and 1657 and in 1654 was appointed commissioner to end small causes. He was reappointed every year until his death except 1657. During that year he was licensed to sell wine and strong liquor to the Indians.

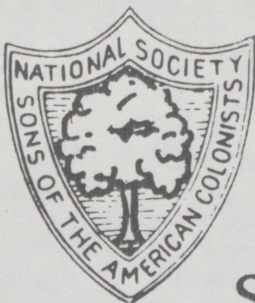

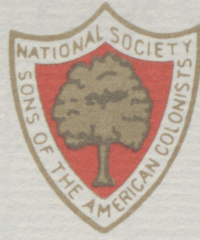

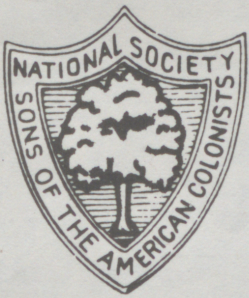

We hope that you will join the National Society S.A.C. in building up the N.S.S.A.C. both with membership and patriotic projects



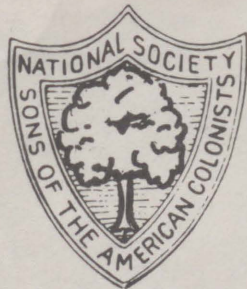

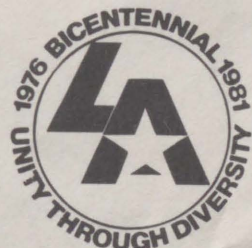
