He is the recipient of numerous awards, including RootsTech's Distinguished Presenter Award and the FGS Award of Merit. Joshua holds an MLS (Archival Management) and an MA (History) from Simmons College and has been a featured genealogist on *Who Do You Think You Are?*. At the present time Joshua can be seen taking America through their past as a host on the popular PBS series *Genealogy Roadshow*.
