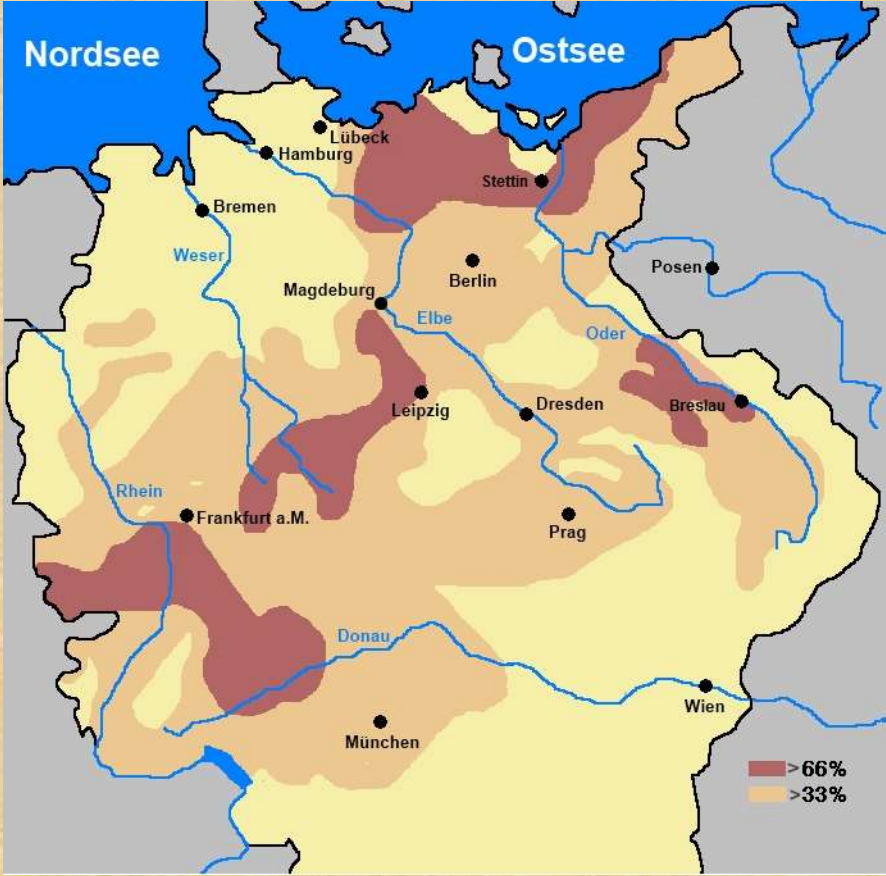
Prelude to Emigration

War Followed by War

The Thirty Years War 1618 to 1648

Considered one of the most destructive wars in European history, estimates of total deaths caused by the conflict range from 4.5 to 8 million, while some areas of Germany experienced population declines of over 50%.

The Nine Years' War 1688 to 1697

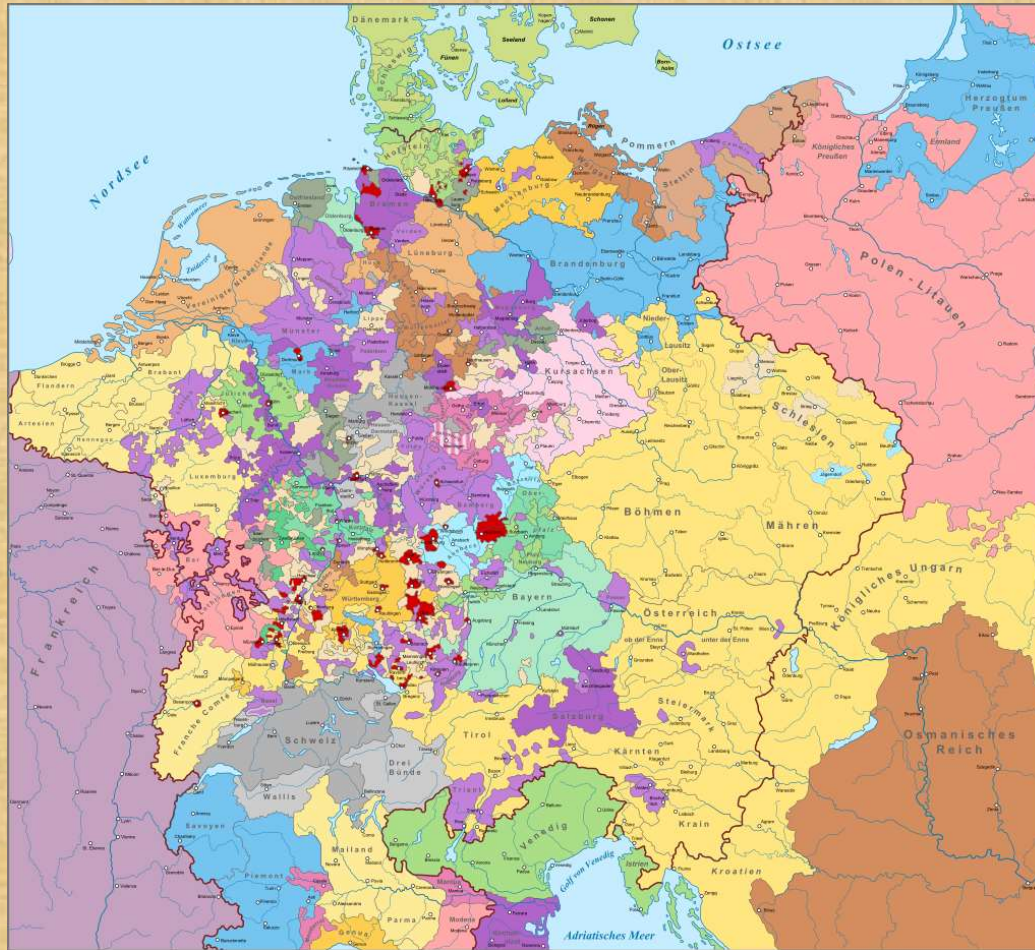
Often called the War of the Grand Alliance,

Key People

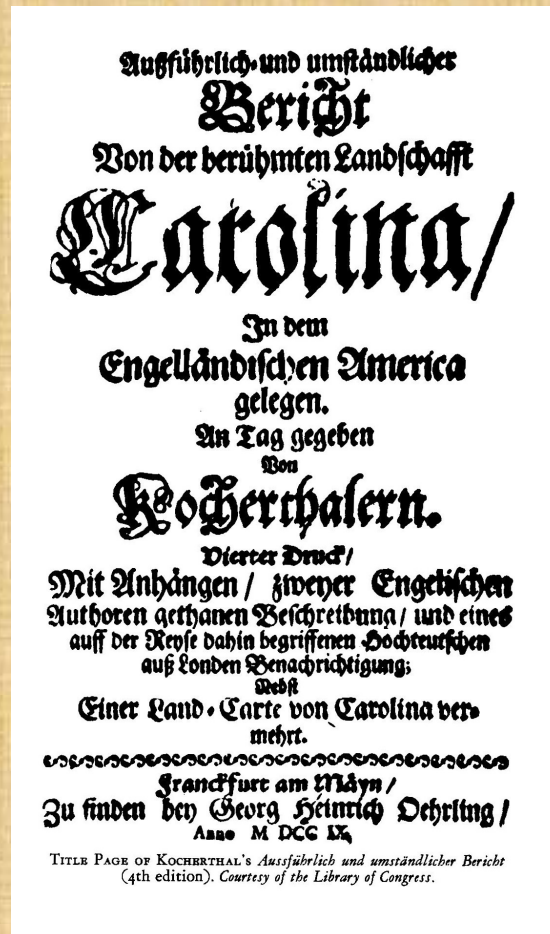
- Rev. Joshua Kocherthal

The First Group - 1708

- Headed by Rev. Joshua Kocherthal
- Fifty-three Palatines
- Voyage lasting about four months
- Spent the winter in New York City
- Settled where Newburgh is now located
- First German Lutheran congregation in the Colony of New York

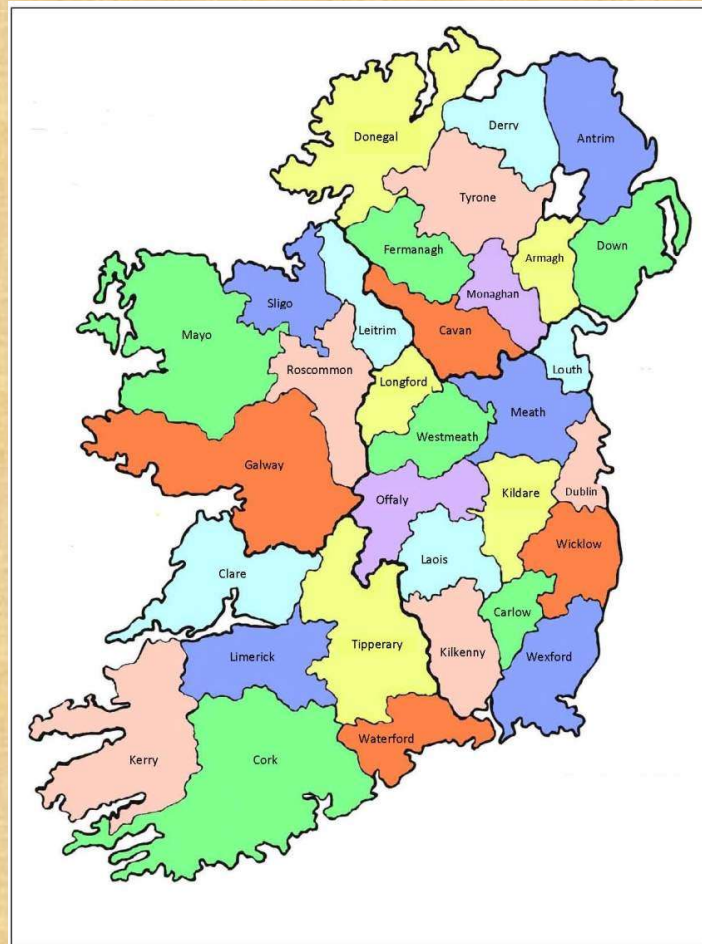

The Journey and Arrival in New York City

- Four thousand Palatines
- Eleven ships
- Boarded on Christmas Day 1709
- Set sail at end of January 1710
- About 700 perished at sea
- One ship foundered near Long Island
- Arrived in New York City July 1710
