
The Palatine Immigration to New York in the 1700's



The Nine Years' War 1688 to 1697





- Continued warfare

- Enticements to come to English colonies

- Headed by Rev. Joshua Kocherthal
- Fifty-three Palatines
- Voyage lasting about four months
- Spent the winter in New York City
- Settled where Newburgh is now located
- First German Lutheran congregation in the Colony of New York


