As you know we have been meeting every other month at the University Park United Methodist Church for the past four years. The facilities have been extremely suitable, but in the last two years there has been strain and some tension on those responsible for arranging the meeting place, since we could book only one meeting a time at the Church, and then only ninety days in advance. Luckily we were able to reserve a meeting room there when needed, with the only adjustment being a change in room designation from time to time in the last two years. After much investigation of a possible meeting place, centrally located, economical, where reservations could be booked for the entire year in advance, your Dallas Genealogical Society Board has decided that all meetings for the 1982-1983 year will be in the Auditorium and Meeting Rooms of the new Dallas Public Library, 1515 Young St., bounded by Ervay, Young and Wood.

We are aware many are opposed to going downtown and walking to a parking lot at night, or in the heat or weather for the day meetings, but this should no longer pose a problem as the Dallas Public Library has a parking garage under the Library. Guards are on duty at the gate and in the Library entrance. Enter the parking area from Wood Street, take one of the elevators up to the main floor and cross the outside foyer of the Library to the meeting facilities.
