Some of our members have attended meetings of the City Council and the Town Meetings where such matters have been discussed, but have been greatly outnumbered by the persons speaking up for such groups as Parks and Recreation, etc. WE CARE what happens to the Library, and now is the time to SPEAK The Non-Circulating collections in the Library have the most to lose: <u>Genealogy</u>, <u>Fine Books</u>, <u>Texas/Dallas</u>, <u>and Government Publications</u>. Another big concern for all of us is the proposed tremendous cut in the amount of money available for Security in the Library.
