RENEWED CONCERN ABOUT LIBRARY BUDGET

It would be helpful if you write your City Councilman, the City Manager and Assistant City Manager in charge of the Library, expressing your interest in and concern for our Library System as planning for the new budget gets underway.

We have a first-rate Library System, and to just maintain what we have now, a minimum of \$16.5 million is needed for the 1987-88 Budget. We have added two new branch libraries to the system which is good for our city, but does stretch the amount of money available. Even this month the City Manager reduced the Library's budget 1.8% for this fiscal year, the end result of which is the loss of \$3,000 - \$4,000 out of our Genealogy funds. These are only tentative figures, but we need to keep our concern before city officials.

I G I Purchase Welcome Addition to Genealogy Resources

Many of us have used the Mormon Data Base of the births, baptisms and marriages (from all over the world), which is currently available on 7,752 sheets of microfiche, but has not been available to us here in Dallas. We are most grateful to Jean Tabb for the purchase of the larger portion of this microfiche, and to Lloyd DeWitt Bockstruck who completed the set with the purchase of the microfiche for Scotland. So we now have a complete set on order, and it should soon be available to all of us.

Our new DGS project is the acquisition of the MCCUBBINS COLLECTION -- on 76 rolls of microfilm of data assembled on early Piedmont North Carolina families. 8000 surnames are referred to in the 150,000 pieces of genealogical material -- previously available to us only by going to Salisbury, NC where the Collection is housed in the Rowan Public Library. Old Rowan County covered 26 North Carolina counties and parts of Tennessee, areas settled by English Quakers, Pennsylvania Dutch and Scots Irish. The wealth of the material is enormous, and we are eager to complete our needed funds (all of which must be in hand before it can be ordered). Donations and Memorials are welcome for this latest project in 1987 -- celebrating the 200th Anniversary of our Constitution. (The rolls of film cost \$20.00 each).
