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NATIONAL GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY HONORS LLOYD DEWITT BOCKSTRUCK

The National Genealogical Society's Third Annual Conference, meeting in Port Worth, Texas, in April, 1983, presented to Lloyd DeWitt Bockstruck the Award of Merit "in recognition of his distinguished work in the field of genealogy as compiler or Colonial Soldiers of Virginia (soon to be published), as a highly respected lecturer and teacher, and as head of the Genealogy Section of the Dallas Public Library since 1973."

Other DGS members honored at the Third Annual Conference of the National Genealogical Society were Mrs. Harry Joseph Morris, of Dallas, Mrs. Mary N. Speakman, of Wichita Falls, and Mr. Weldon I. Hudson, of Fort Worth. (See Page 114, this issue)

PAST PRESIDENT'S REPORT

All of our monthly meetings for 1982-83 were held in the Auditorium or East/West rooms of the Dallas Public Library, a decision which was arrived at after long and tiresome investigation regarding where we could meet that would be convenient for members, economical, and where meetings could be scheduled in advance for the entire year. This change met with great response, and proved to be satisfactory in all aspects.

In June, 1982, the previous DGS administration introduced genealogical charts and forms to be sold by our Society, both at our meetings and in the Genealogy Section of the Dallas Public Library. This has met with enthusiastic response during the year, and this administration commends our previous administration for initiating the project, which has met a need among

our members and among the patrons of the Library.

A new DGS membership form was introduced this year, which included space for surnames and states our members are currently interested in. These surnames are to be published later

this year, along with the membership list.

After several years of groundwork and planning, the first volume of Dallas County Cemetery Inscriptions became a reality. The title selected was "Dallas County, Texas: Genealogical Data from Early Cemeteries." This project has been approved by the Texas Sesquicentennial Committee as a Sesquicentennial Project for our Society, giving us an active part in celebrating the forthcoming 150th Anniversary of the Republic of Texas. This volume has already proven helpful to many researchers having Dallas County ancestors, and we can be proud we have helped preserve this part of the County's early pioner history.

Our By-Laws underwent a major revision this year. While some of the sections required only rewording, others required more attention. The major changes were in updating and rearranging some of the duties of the Executive Board. However, the most drastic change was to eliminate the June Meeting, thus moving our annual business meeting and election of officers to May, with the new administration taking over their duties on June 1st of each year. These changes in the By-Laws were presented at the February, 1983, meeting, and were read and voted on at the March meeting.

DGS was well-represented at the National Genealogical Society Conference held in Ft. Worth in April, 1983. We made many good contacts throughout the U. S., and added several new

members to our Society.

It was with sadness that we paid our last respects to Mrs. Margaret Barrett Pratt, founder of the Genealogy Department of the Dallas Public Library in 1956. She was also one of the Charter Members of our Society. A special memorial was given

to the Genealogy Department in her memory.

In November, 1982, a half day Beginner's Workshop was held attended by over 100 participants. Our Annual Spring Workshop was filled to capacity with over 200 participants. We not only served our Society, but our community, with these two outstanding functions.

Our Society chose two major projects this year through which to channel research materials to the Genealogy Section of the Dallas Public Library: first, the microfilm publication "Massachusetts Soldiers and Sailors," which through gifts was completed almost immediately. Our second selection of research materials was the early tax records of Kentucky. From our annual gift, the tax records through 1860 were ordered for the Genealogy Section, totaling an additional 126 reels of microfilmed tax records. Any funds remaining from our annual gift were used for materials for the Genealogical Section, and the selection was left to the discretion of the Section Head.

As is our policy, we sent a memorial gift to the Genealogy Section in memory of our deceased members. This year's memorial

was for \$100.00.

At our Annual Meeting in May, we presented our annual gift to the Genealogy Section of the Dallas Public Library. This year's gift was \$3,000.00, which went toward our projects enumerated above.

Two assets were added to the equipment of DGS this year, one being a two-drawer legal file cabinet for use of the President, and the other a small calculator for use of the Treasurer. Both of these purchases were desperately needed, and will receive much use in years to come.

It has been a wonderful year for our Society, and one in

which we can all feel proud to have had a part.

As my year as your President comes to an end, I thank all of you for your support, -- with a very special thanks to the wonderful Board Members that have helped make this year a success.

GEORGE BOONE - SON OF EDWARD BOONE, KILLED BY THE INDIANS IN 1780, AND NEPHEW OF DANIEL BOONE, THE FAMED EXPLORER. (The subtitle is: "A History of the Boone Family, Including Descendants of George and Patty Hazelrigg Boone and George and Hester Locke Boone").

8½"x11", hardbound, 336 pp. (No information on price).

This genealogy deals with Boones out of Pennsylvania, Kentucky, and North Carolina. It traces seven generations of Boones, and focuses on George and his descendants. One of the families lightly mentioned

is that of Daniel Boone, the explorer.

Not only is this a genealogy of one Boone family, but it includes these collateral families: Boykin, Bryan, Cleveland, Hazelrigg, Morgan, Reinhardt, Spears, and Wynne. For added interest, the authors have linked the collateral lines into royal genealogies, but they warn that these are not adequately proven. Especially interesting are the Bouchier family traced to Charlemagne, and the Morgan family traced to Cwynedd, Cymric King in 605 A.D.

There are generous sprinklings of footnores and excellent references (See "Bryan Family"). Also helpful is the heavy print used for names, surnames and given names, too. For proof, the actual photocopies of documents and county records are included. Most of these are legible

and not too difficult to read.

There is an Index of all names, and an Addenda at the end of this, also an Index of photographs. The printing is large and clear, and easy to read. It is a clean, neat, handsome book.

*** For those without Boone ancestors: peak inside the back cover and note the sign pictured there!

COOPER FAMILY HISTORY - 1730-1982 - WITH ALLIED LINES. Bryan, Thomas R. and C. C. Ellenberg, 1982, 6"x9", 192pp. hardbound. Order from A Press, Inc., P. O. Box 8796, Greenville, SC 29604. \$25. plus \$1.85 postage.

This is the history of the descendants of Reuban Cooper I, a Welshman who came to the Colonies before the Revolutionary War. Part of this Cooper family settled in South Carolina, the others moved into Virginia. This genealogy is well documented with military and county courthouse records, and the major discrepancies are honestly questioned.

The main collateral lines of this Cooper family are Townsend, Sloan, Benson, and Johnson, and many of these people are shown in por-

traits and family snapshots.

The book is a pleasure to read, and the method for differentiating generations is easy to follow; however, there are erros in the Surname Index. An example: Ella Gertrude Walton is mentioned on p. 130, but there is no listing in the Index for Walton. Also, Martha Prince is mentioned on p. 155, but in the Index, she is listed as Martha Price.

Beginners note: Information may be included in the book, but

not listed in the Index.

FINCHER IN THE USA - 1682-1900. Evelyn D. Fincher and Ann Wilson Fincher, 1981, 6"x9", 626pp, hardbound. Order from A Press, Inc., P. O. Box 8796, Greenville, SC 29604. \$25. plus \$1.85 postage.

The Fincher genealogy is an impressive book. Not only is thansive in appearance, but very complete in its scope. The introduction gives a biographical sketch on each of the six known Fincher immigrants who left Europe in the 17th, 18th, and 19th centuries. Part I is the genealogy of one of these men: Francis Fincher, the Quaker, and his descendants. Part II consists of Finchers "found in North Carolina and elsewhere." The life of each of the descendants with his collateral lines is concisely and completely related in separate chapters.

The form of this book is easy to follow, with references contained within the text. These references range from county histories and censuses to county courthouse records and archival files - - and all appear to be quite complete. Pagination is different, with p. 20 followed by p. 302a, and p. 294 followed by 294a. Twenty-six pages

of an every-name index complete the book.

Beginners note: This is an excellent example of a family genealogy. It is well researched, very thorough, and has good form.


