You can access these databases from your home computer if you have a DPL library card or use them in person at any of DPL's <u>locations</u>.

To access the first two sources, choose the Databases tab on DPL's home page and click on the TexShare link near the bottom. Scroll down this page to find the icons that link you to the databases.

Fold3 is accessed differently - from the Databases tab, click on the Fold3 link. This takes you to a list of databases available from their provider EBSCO. Choose the last icon at the bottom of the page Footnote (the former name of Fold3).
