Pleasant Mound Cemetery BillionGraves Project

Friday and Saturday, April 22-23, 2016, volunteers from DGS photographed the tombstones in historic Pleasant Mound Cemetery and Agudas Achim Cemetery. This project was conducted in cooperation with BillionGraves.com and MyHeritage.com. Using the BillionGraves smartphone app, images have now been uploaded to the BillionGraves website by the DGS group and

be to educate, by creating, fostering, and maintaining interest in genealogy; to assist and support the genealogy section of the J. Erik Jonsson Central Library in Dallas, Texas, or to its legal successor; and to collect, preserve, copy, and index information relating to Dallas County and its early history.



Individuals are in the process of transcribing the photos they uploaded.

We currently have 2,588 photos uploaded for Pleasant Mound Cemetery with 1,763 transcriptions entered. We have 591 tombstones for Agudas Achim with 352 transcriptions entered.

Dallas County Probate Records Project

This indexing project focuses on the Dallas County Probate Records from 1850 to the early 1900's that are now available on <u>The Portal to Texas History</u>. Volunteers are adding date information to the records.



Thanks to our dedicated members we are making good progress: 146 more cases were completed in May. Overall we have completed 18% of the cases.

...After retirement he became deeply involved in the hobby of genealogy, serving with the Dallas Genealogical Society as its president from 1994 to 1995. He was a writer for Genealogical Computing magazine with a regular column reviewing software programs of interest to genealogists. He was a co-founder of GENTECH, a national organization to promote technology for genealogy, and served as its

secretary from 1998 until its merger with the National Genealogical Society in 2002.
