A Historical Cemetery Marker in Grand Prairie

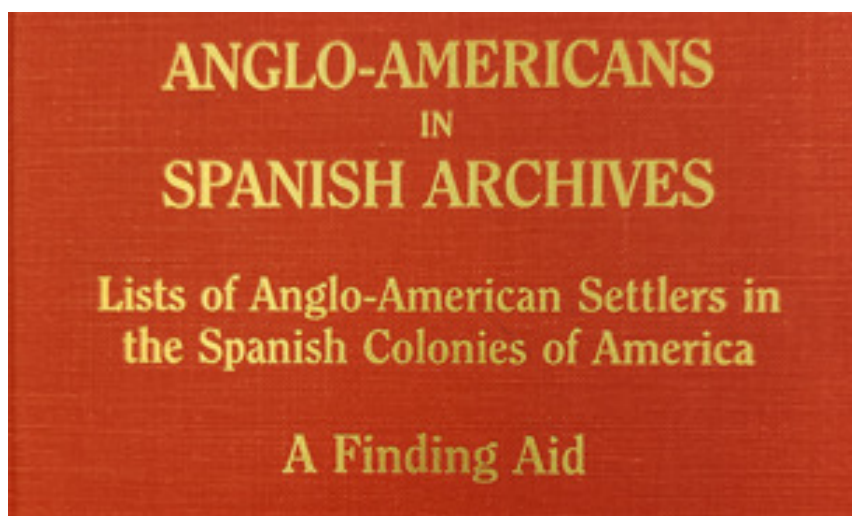
The Antioch Cemetery in Grand Prairie received its historical marker in June 2022.
